

What about Membership?

What does it mean to be a church "member?" In relation to the church, the concept of membership often gets watered down compared to the New Testament's definition of "member." When Paul speaks of being a member of the church in Romans 12:4-8 and 1 Corinthians 12:12-31, he uses "member" synonymously with "body part." In comparing the church to a physical body, Paul says every Christian is a member or part of the body. God puts us together to collectively form one, fully functioning, healthy body. That means God intends for each Christian to be an active, supportive part/member of the body. This takes the idea of membership far beyond simply having one's name on a roll or in a church directory.

Nowhere in the New Testament will you encounter the idea of "placing membership" within a local church. Because of this, some challenge the idea of placing membership. It is true that all Christians are members of God's universal church, and He certainly doesn't need us validating what He has already accomplished (Acts 2:47; 2 Timothy 2:19). However, there are some practical reasons for being identified with a specific congregation. Here are a couple:

- The shepherds/elders of the local church need to know for what sheep they are responsible. Some sheep may want to be spiritual free agents, but that's not how God intended for the church to function. He has called shepherds to oversee, lead and protect the flock. If you trust the leadership of the local church, then you need to become a part of that flock. If you don't trust the leadership of the local church, then you need to find one that you do.
- Returning to the idea of membership from Romans 12 and 1 Corinthians 12, God has called you to get connected to other Christians in order that all can serve and grow together. We each have unique talents and abilities to contribute to the greater body. Those in positions of leadership are commanded to train and mentor members for service (Ephesians 4:11-16). These purposes can only be accomplished through a commitment to one another. In other words, we need all hands on deck!

Church membership is not about gaining "preferred" status within the local congregation. It is about confidently following the leadership; contributing talents and resources to the service of others; and serving as an ambassador for Christ by bringing more souls to Him (2 Corinthians 5:18-20). If you have any questions about us or would like to meet with our elders about placing membership, they are happy to speak with you at any time.
