

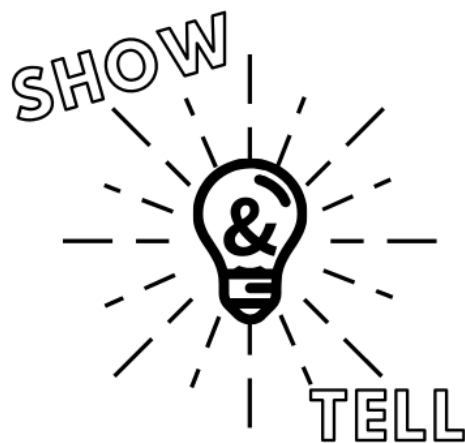

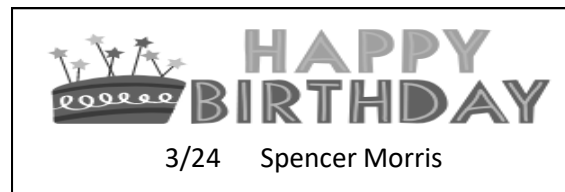


SERVICES CANCELED: Due to concerns with COVID-19, all church services and events are canceled through Wednesday, April 1.
