From the Elders

The Elders would like to provide some information concerning the building program and needed repairs to the church building and the house.

We began a building fund program in 2008 and developed plans for a multipurpose building to be built between the present classroom wing and the house. At that time, the estimated cost of the new structure was \$800,000. We decided to begin the project once we had one-half the funds on hand. When we reached \$300,00 in the Building Fund, we contacted the architect, who is an elder of the congregation at Laure, and received a new estimate. At that point, it was more than one million dollars. Not wanting to put the congregation in long-term debt, especially with the downturn in the economy, we requested a redesign of the building to approximately half the original planned size. The architect then shopped the project with some contractors for a current estimate, and the cost of the smaller building was nearly a million dollars. At that time, we suspended collection funds for a building project.

We currently have some needed repairs for the existing building and the house. Here are the estimates for needed projects:

Church Building

 New roof for the church building 	\$33,000
 Guttering 	5,000
 Lining the parking lot 	2,000
 HVAC replacing 35 yr. old original units 	25,000
 Landscaping 	5,000
House	
 Bathrooms, plumbing, and electrical repairs 	<u>\$15,000</u>

We are reluctant to use the building funds for needed repairs because the congregation gave the funds for new construction. Our plans for the year are to designate the four fifth-Sundays contribution and other special contributions for these repair projects. If these contributions are not enough to cover these repair costs, the remaining balances will be paid from the Building Fund account.
