Church & Crying Children

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19:14). For as long as people have been gathering for worship services, there have been babies and children who cry in those worship services. As a parent, I know the frustration that comes with those tears. Kids (like adults) sometimes have bad days. Maybe they're tired. Maybe they're hungry. Maybe the preacher is going longer than he should. Yes, preachers sometimes go longer than they should.

I can't help but think that to God's ears, however, those cries ascend to Him like "a sacrifice of praise" (Hebrews 13:15). While little children may not appreciate everything that takes place within worship, their presence certainly praises and honors the Lord, and He welcomes them just as must as he welcomes adults.

On a personal note as a preacher, let me also say this: Crying children are blessings among us. Parents and grandparents sometimes apologize to me after worship for a child being noisy. More times than not, I never noticed what they were talking about. Even on those rare occasions when a disruption might occur, we should all rejoice over the presence of little souls among us.

I briefly want to share a different kind phenomenon, however, taking place among our church that involves crying children. I know of at least two occasions recently when children have cried because they had to miss church on Wednesday night. Kids who cry FOR church — What a beautiful sound that must be to God!

Parents and guardians, you are to be commended for making every effort to be among us. Getting everyone ready, fed and transported on Wednesday evenings takes planning, effort and sacrifice. But please know this: It is worth it, and your children are being blessed. Planting such seeds in your children's hearts allows God's harvest to grow throughout their lives. You will never regret your commitment.

Teachers, you are to be commended for creating learning environments in which God is glorified, the Bible is honored, and young minds are nurtured through special consideration of how children think and learn. You are making a difference!

Church family, you are to be commended for fostering an atmosphere of love in which children long to be among us. It is a beautiful sight to see so many families enjoying being together at the building long after our services have concluded. Having such brothers and sisters provides spiritual fuel to help us through the week.

If you have not been with us recently on Wednesdays or other times, join us soon to see what you've been missing. Church is more than showing up for worship. It is about sharing life together as disciples and helping each other as disciples. Such a church life is already shaping little hearts for the Lord.
