We Had Hoped

"We had hoped." Those words come from two of Jesus' disciples in Luke 24:21 following his crucifixion. Spoken in the past tense, "We had hoped" also implies "We no longer hope."

Few things hurt like unfulfilled hope. We all know the pain of such disappointment.

These disciples had no reason to be hopeless, however. They soon learned that the resurrected Jesus was alive, well and standing in their presence!

Why had the disciples given up hope so easily? Because the object of their hope was too shallow and short-sighted. They hoped Jesus would redeem Israel back to prominence (Luke 24:21). Jesus later revealed that his mission was far bigger (Luke 24:45-47).

Like the disciples, our hopes sometimes suffer from being too small.

Right now we all hope that the pandemic will soon end. But what if it doesn't? Can you and I still live with hope? We absolutely can!

That's because Christ offers a hope that extends beyond the circumstances of "here and now." The disciples discovered that here and now will sometimes be painful and unpredictable. When the things for which I hope slip through my fingers, I am only being reminded that my hopes were misplaced and too small. When my hope goes beyond here and now, however, I can continue to live with hope right here and right now.

Instead of saying "We had hoped," in Christ we can all proclaim, "We hope for something more." — Blaine
