Dear Church Family,

It is always a blessing when the church gathers together, but this is a Sunday we will undoubtedly long remember. As special as it may be, this Sunday is also a little different. To help all of us spiritually prepare for worship, we thought it would be beneficial to provide you the following details regarding this Sunday's service:

- Masks: We strongly encourage the wearing of masks, especially when entering and exiting the building. How you go about wearing a mask throughout service is up to each family and individual. We simply ask that masks not be a divisive issue among us.
- Parking: You are welcome to park wherever you wish.
- Entrances: Our three main entrances will be open. Someone will be stationed at each door to open it for you and welcome you to service.
- Social Distancing: You will find markers in the hallway that help us maintain proper distancing. As you approach the auditorium, ushers will direct you to a specific pew. Families will be seated together.
- Worship Items: Before entering the auditorium, please pickup your communion packet. There will also be a box where you can easily leave your contribution.
- Restrooms: You will find signs on the restroom doors indicating "vacant" or "occupied." We ask that only one person go to the restroom at a time, unless an adult is accompanying a child. Please change the sign as you enter and exit.
- Announcements: Blaine will cover general announcements as you enter the auditorium. Once everyone is assembled, he will highlight a few special announcements from the past ten weeks.

- Worship: Our worship service will last approximately 45-50 minutes.
- Order of Service: (1) Family Matters/Prayer (2) Song (3) Sermon (4) Invitation Song (5) Song before Communion (6) Communion (7) Closing Prayer
- Invitation: As in recent livestream services, we will ask that responses to the invitation be made by texting Blaine at 423.736.1505. If someone would prefer to meet with the elders in private, that option will continue to be available.
- Dismissal: You will be formally dismissed by row at the end of worship. As you exit, please place communion items in the hallway trash can. If you wish to visit with others after worship, please do so away from the building's entrances.
