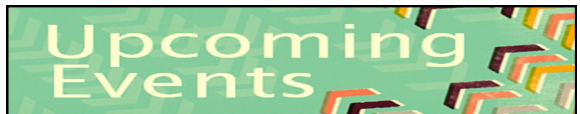
**PLAYGROUND:** The playground is under construction currently for VBS. Please keep children off of it today. Thank you!
