## Paul and Timothy

Beginning Discussion: Who are some church members or Christians that you look up to? Whose example are you watching and learning from? Who is looking up to, watching, and learning from you?

Read Acts 2 Timothy 1:1-7.

When the apostle Paul traveled throughout his missionary days, he came to the town of Lystra where he met a young man named Timothy. Acts 16:2 says that other people of Lystra had very good things to say about Timothy. Paul was so impressed by this young man that he asked Timothy to join him on his missionary journeys. From that moment forward, Timothy experienced the highs and lows of spreading the gospel throughout the world. Along the way, a very special bond developed between Paul and Timothy. By the time Paul writes 2 Timothy, the apostle calls Timothy “my beloved child” (2 Timothy 1:2). Even though Timothy was not actually Paul’s son, he had become like a son to Paul.

Read 2 Timothy 4:6-9.

As we read Paul’s letter to Timothy, we learn that the apostle is nearing the end of his life. He is not afraid, though. In fact, Paul finds great confidence and comfort in what Jesus had done for him. Even though Paul would die, he knew that there was a “crown of righteousness” that awaited him in eternity. He also uses his letter to encourage Timothy to continue being the man God would have him to be and to follow in Paul’s example. But it is clear that Paul wants to see Timothy — his “beloved child” — one last time before he dies.

In Paul and Timothy’s relationship, we see just how special others beyond our own physical family can be to us. Because of Jesus, we can all be a part of God’s family and we can support and encourage one another to live forever with Him!

DISCUSSION: What are some ways we can help support and encourage people of different ages among our church family? Who are some people that you or your family can encourage?

PRAYER: Thank God for the special relationships He gives us within the church, and pray for certain people who are especially on your heart.

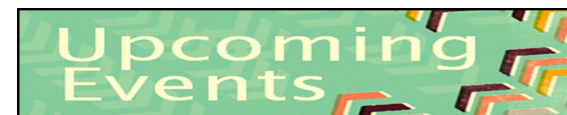
