- 216 different people have received lessons.
- Lessons have been sent to 9 different detention facilities.
- 12 students have completed the first five lessons and received a Bible from World Bible School.
- 10 more students are currently working on lessons four and five.
- 1 student has already completed ALL lessons from World Bible School.
- We have received 1 baptism request and are currently checking into how we can serve this situation.
