Fall Bible Classes

As of today, the new quarter of adult and teen Bible classes is in full swing. Here is a rundown of those classes:

- Sunday Adult Auditorium — Acts: David Willbanks leads the continued study of the book of Acts and topics connected to it.
- Sunday Mustard Seeds — “Stories of the Bible”: To understand God’s message to us, we must read Scripture how it was designed to be read. Mike Sobiech leads this study of the spiritual artistry of biblical stories.
- Sunday Teens — “The Blessed Life”: The Bible is full of “blessed are . . .” statements that are often referred to as Beatitudes. Russ Mitchell will help teens understand what this life looks like and how we can attain it.
- Wednesday Adults & Teens: “The Disciple Peter” — We often refer to him as the Apostle Peter, but Peter’s life as a disciple is covered in more detail than any other of Jesus’ followers. What does his discipleship teach us about our own discipleship? This class will explore Peter’s discipleship as depicted in the Gospels. Blaine Kelly teaches the adults, and John Dean will be teaching the teen class.
- Wednesday 1st through 5th Grade Kids: “Foundations” — This quarter will be used to explore what the Bible teaches about God, Jesus, God’s plan for man, God’s plan for the church and God’s plan for me. The class will serve to lay a foundation for helping children understand why we believe what we believe and why we do what we do. If you have any questions or would like more information, please see Caroline Kelly.

Deeper & Higher: Church Retreat 2019

Our annual church retreat is just three weeks away! This year’s retreat “Deeper and Higher” will challenge us to go beyond a status quo faith. If want to live out your discipleship in more meaningful ways, then this retreat is for you!
